### **Uniform Standards**

As the sun is shining and the summer weather is here, please could you ensure your child comes to school with a labelled water bottle and a sun hat. It is also a good time to ensure that children's jumpers and cardigans are clearly labelled as throughout the day these are taken off and can be left on the field or playground at break and lunchtimes.

Ideally sun cream will be applied in the morning before school but if you feel your child will need to re-apply sunscreen during the day then please ensure it is clearly labelled with your child's full name and this can be left at school.

There will be a tray kept in each classroom for children to keep their sunscreen in. Children will be able to re-apply their sun cream at break and lunch time if needed, overseen by staff on duty.

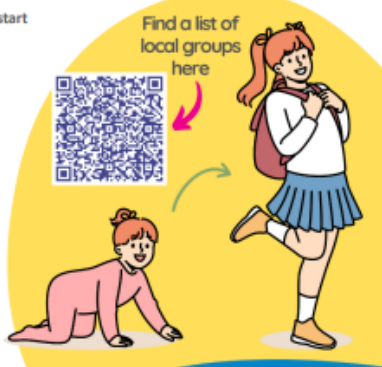
